## Summary of Activities

### COMMUNICATION & EDUCATION

#### Education

Community-specific videos, scripts, storytelling; statewide health equity conference

#### Media

Community-specific media such as websites, bus wraps

#### Virtual/social media

Social media strategies for Somali and urban Hispanic/Latino communities

#### Language

Spanish, Somali

#### Message development

Culturally specific images, messages, events, and messengers developed in partnership with each community using 8-week Boot Camp Translation process with 12-15 community participants each

### VACCINATIONS

- Partnered with culturally relevant events in each community such as Dia de los Muertos celebrations



## Summary of Activities

### COMMUNITY EDUCATORS

- Community Connectors hired in each community to support survey data collection, organize community events, disseminate materials.

### CLINICAL TRIALS RECRUITMENT

- Created new CCTAB including community members and researchers
- Engagement with local RECOVER study as part of the Mountain States Consortium
