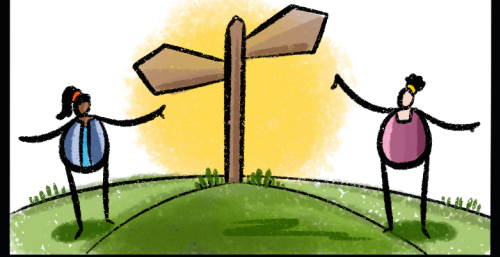

USE SIMPLE CONSENT LANGUAGE AND PROCESSES



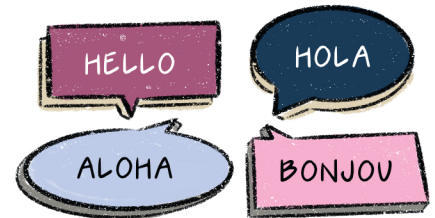
